The Pittsburgh Steelers hold their annual training camp at St. Vincent College, Westmoreland County. The Steelers have held their annual pre-season training camp there since 1967. Practices are held daily (morning and afternoon) from mid-July to late August but the public is permitted to watch, at no charge, only during the first two weeks (and only at designated times.) Heinz field is the home of the Pittsburgh Steelers and seats approximately 65,000 fans.

PNC Park, is the home of the Pittsburgh Pirates. The ballpark is located on Pittsburgh's North Side adjacent to the Allegheny River and Federal Street. The ballpark features a natural grass playing surface, and seats approximately 38,000 fans.
